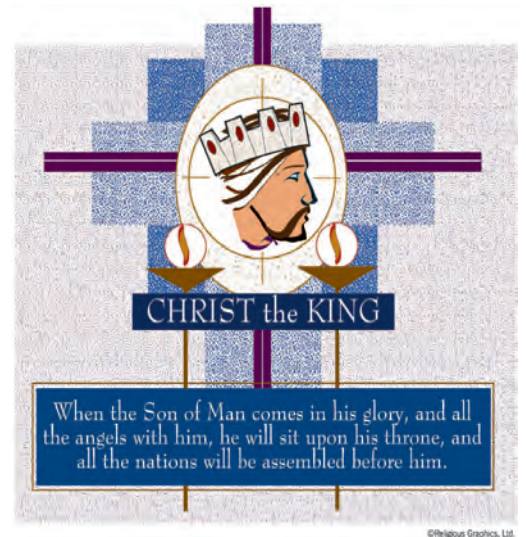

## a letter from the pastor

This weekend, we celebrate the Feast of Christ the King. This Feast marks the end of a liturgical year and alerts us that next weekend we begin a new liturgical year with the Season of Advent.

This coming Thursday we celebrate Thanksgiving. It is oftentimes a wonderful day to gather with family and friends and reflect on the blessings of the past year. This celebration offers us a sense of renewed hope as we acknowledge our blessings and anticipate the coming of a new year. Our celebrations this Thanksgiving will be somewhat different. Many have suffered the painful loss of a loved one; others are saddened by the inability of people to travel this year and the restrictions on the number of guests we can invite for the celebrations. Through the prayers we will pray on this Thanksgiving Day, let us remember that our God is with us and that he will continue to sustain us each day. When we sit down for dinner at our tables, let us join in prayer with family and friends. You might also light a candle remembering those who are no longer with us and then those unable to be with us this Thanksgiving.

While not a Holy Day of Obligation many people begin their Thanksgiving Day celebration by coming to Church to offer God their thanks and praise for the blessings in their lives including but not limited to the gifts of life, faith, dear families and friends, the country in which we live, and the list goes on .... Why not join your fellow parishioners for the Thanksgiving Day Mass at 9:30 AM in Church? The staff at HNJ joins me in extending to you our prayerful best wishes for a Happy Thanksgiving Day

Just a reminder that throughout the year, the parish food pantry receives your generous donations of nonperishable foods to assist families from our parish and the surrounding areas. Your continued food donations are much appreciated. If you are interested in helping to "set the table" for a family this Christmas, in lieu of donating nonperishable foods, you might consider a gift card from one of the local food establishments so that families can choose the food of their choice. At this time of the year, I call your attention to the fact that gift card scams are on the rise. About a year and one half ago, there was a scam which included text messages and emails asking for help for someone seriously ill. Some of texts and emails listed my name or the names of other priests. A similar scam has resurfaced and is asking for donations during the upcoming holiday season. *Please be aware that neither the Church, nor the Diocese, nor any priest I know are asking for such donations using emails or texts. So, please, do not respond to any such emails or texts.* If you have any doubts or questions, you can always call the rectory office.

Once again, I take this opportunity to say thank you to all our parishioners who have not forgotten the parish during these difficult times. I thank you for your generosity and support. I also extend a sincere thank you to our parishioners who are not with us on a weekly basis yet continue to support the Church regularly by mailing their contributions or donating online. Thank you, one and all.

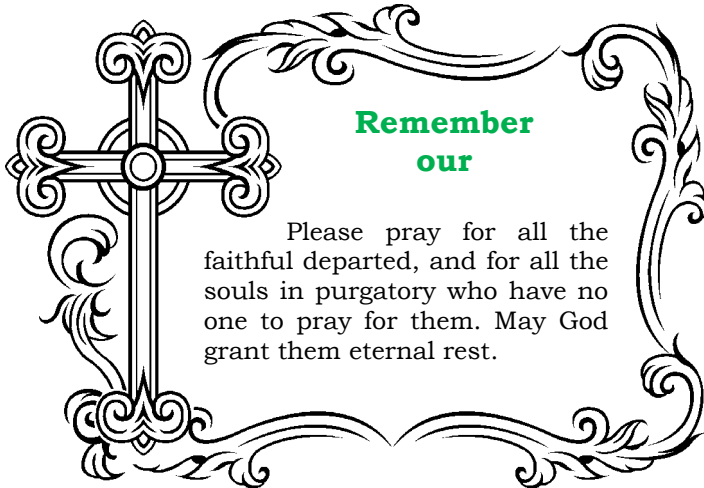
*In the second reading*, Paul writes to the Corinthians, telling them that as *Christ has been raised from the dead*, then so too *in Christ shall all be brought to life*.

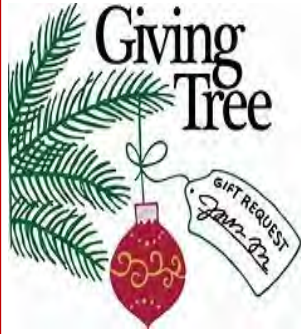

**Christmas Card Drive:** Holy Name of Jesus would like to provide greetings at Christmas time to help alleviate the loneliness and depression in our 3 nursing homes. We recently sent each resident personal notes; the recreation director at one of those nursing homes was so thankful that all of the stress of the past half-year just bubbled to the surface in tears. She said it has been so hard on the residents and the staff and they were very appreciative of our efforts. So what I am asking is that we each try to write some extra cards this year; , just a “Hello friend” and sign with something like “you are loved” or “you are thought of” and your first name; 20-40 of these can be done in no time since neither stamps nor addresses are needed. Currently the 900 beds in our 3 nursing homes have about 700 residents so we need a lot of cards! The Congregants at a local Jewish temple agreed to write Hanukkah cards. Cards can be dropped off in the box in the narthex of the church until Dec.15th. Please bundle them as spiritual, generic Christmas or generic holiday greetings. . We will make sure that the Catholic residents get the spiritual ones.



**Christmas Caroling by ZOOM:** We all love to sing Christmas Carols and somehow, they always sound beautiful, not because we have great voices, but because we love Jesus, they make us feel good and they come from the heart! I am looking for volunteers to sing Christmas Carols to be taped during a ZOOM session. The recorded session will then be played at our local nursing homes.
